Originally used as staff accommodation for nurses and groundskeepers of the former quarantine station, the cottages were built just after Federation in 1909 and retain some of the original heritage features.

Each cottage has been restored and furnished to the highest standard, with stylish and modern conveniences including three bedrooms with double beds, living room with flat-screen TV, kitchenette and garden in which to watch the sunset and take in the panoramic views of Sydney Harbour or the National Park. Guests can cook a meal on the stovetop in the kitchen; sizzle steaks on a BBQ in the garden; visit Q Station's Boilerhouse Restaurant; or even take a trip into Manly.

Whether you are looking to catch up with your friends, celebrate a birthday, enjoy a private honeymoon or anniversary; the cottages are perfect for groups with their own agenda and those looking for an escape without having to leave Sydney.

There are various activities to keep you entertained such as early morning jogs along North Head, tranquil bushwalks, kayaking off Quarantine Beach or taking part in a Q Station historical tour. There is a free shuttle to Manly so you can tour the Concourse and shops or for those looking for a little quiet time, simply enjoy sitting in your back garden in the company of the local wildlife or watching the breathtaking sunsets.

About Q Station

Q Station offers **accommodation and conference facilities** with spectacular views of Sydney Harbour; **Visitor Centre** on Quarantine Wharf, the **Boilerhouse Restaurant** situated close to the beach; **interactive tours** and **school education programs**.

From the 1830s to 1984 migrant ships arriving in Sydney with suspected contagious disease stopped inside North Head and off-loaded their passengers and crew into quarantine to protect local residents from becoming sick. In some instances, Sydney residents suspected of contagious disease were removed from their homes and quarantined with the immigrants.

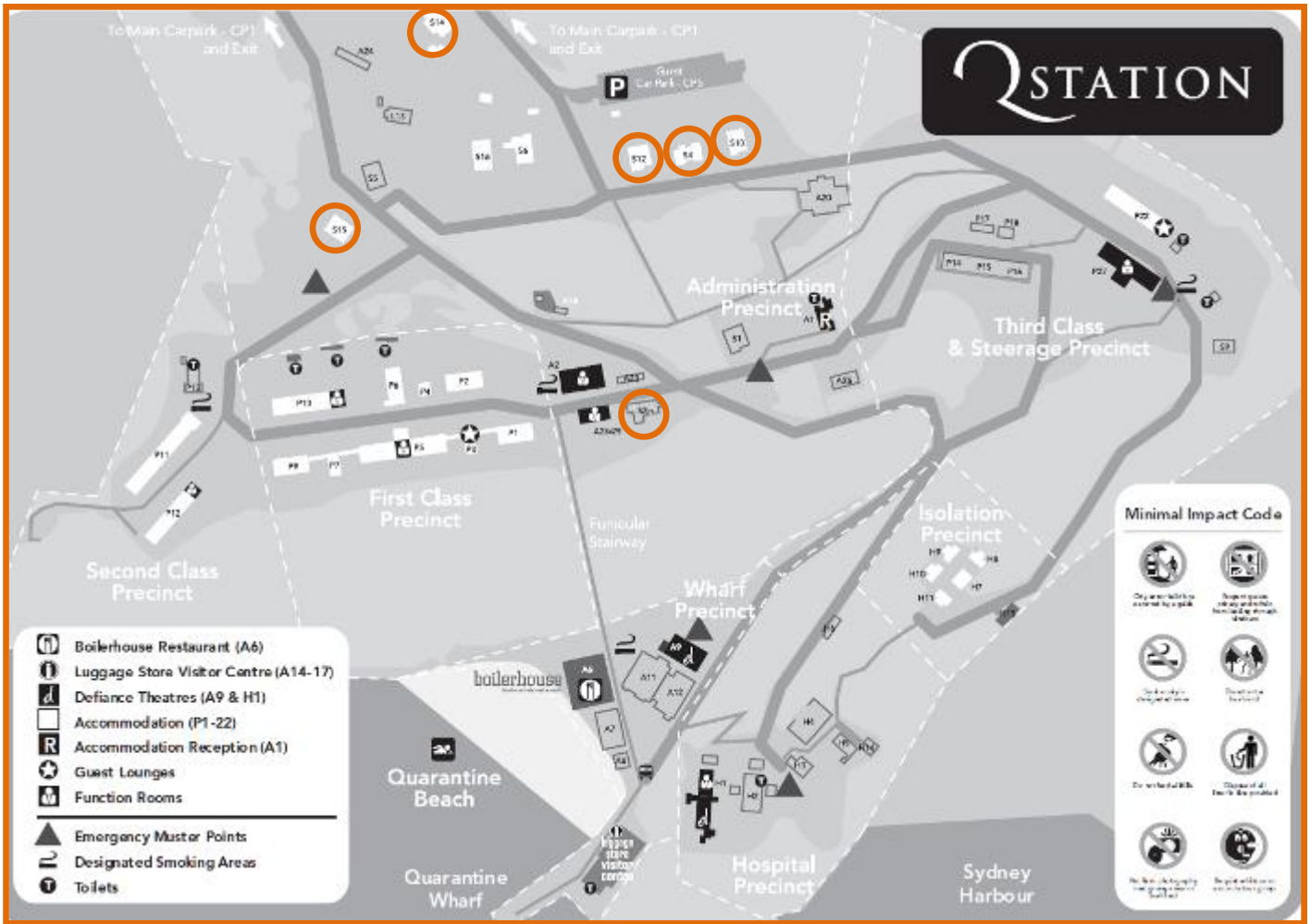
