A2 - DR CUMPSTON ROOM



Originally the former general store and linen room, A2 is the main conference venue for the site. It features views of Sydney Harbour, a vast display wall of heritage objects, air conditioning and reverse cycle heating. This room also has a decking area which is ideal for a break out space or a team BBQ.

H1 - NURSE FORD ROOM



The recently re-constructed former Hospital features lots of natural light, timber floors, and verandas with breath-taking views.

P7 - FORMER LADIES SEWING ROOM



The Former Ladies Sewing Room for First Class passengers offers stunning harbour views from its private veranda and a bright and spacious interior.

P5 - FORMER FIRST CLASS DINING ROOM



The Former First Class Dining Room offers a palm-lined veranda, charming stained glass windows and spectacular bush and harbour views. The Dining Room still utilises the original hardwood chairs that the first class guests used from 1886, when P5 was built.

P12 - DR SALTER ROOM



Close to the harbour's edge, the end verandas of building P12 offer dramatic views across Sydney Harbour.

P27 - GOVERNOR BOURKE ROOM



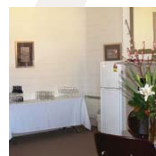
This is our largest venue. It has expansive views of Sydney Harbour, is flooded with natural light and features timber floors and the original dumb waiters which carried food from the kitchen below.

P10 - DR MACKELLAR ROOM



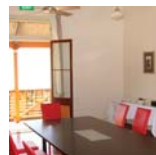
Formerly a lounge in the old First Class precinct this building offers views of Sydney Harbour and the Q Station surrounds.
